

### NEUROPATHIC PAIN: Method of Clinical Assessment & Somatosensory Rehabilitation

The complete training course -150 hours- about somatosensory rehabilitation of neuropathic pain enables the obtention of the **CSTP®** title: Certified Somatosensory Therapist of Pain. This course is intended for therapists, physicians and others and is about a **method** for treating neuropathic pain patients (NPP).

This **1<sup>st</sup> part** implies a total of 60 hours of work dispatched into two sessions of 4 weeks with a tiny break in between:

- 6 **synchronous** live lessons on MS teams;
  - 1) **Conference**
  - 2) **Round table**
- 18 **Asynchronous** lessons at home:
  - 1) **Pre-recorded videos**;
  - 2) Other **didactic material** – ppt/audio/article.

Note: the duration of these 24 lessons is 18 hours

- 20 **tasks to be uploaded** at any time before their DEADlines
- Note: the time required to complete these 20 tasks is 42 hours
